

## The Bible Recap Discussion Questions

### January 29<sup>th</sup>-February 4<sup>th</sup>

#### January 29: Exodus 4-6

1. **God's Patience with Moses:** How does God's response to Moses' doubts and excuses reveal His patience and provision for those He calls?
2. **Pharaoh's Hard Heart:** What does Pharaoh's resistance to God teach about human pride and the consequences of defying God's will?
3. **God's Covenant Name:** How does God's declaration of His name, Yahweh, deepen your understanding of His character and faithfulness?

#### January 30: Exodus 7-9

1. **God's Power Over Creation:** How do the plagues demonstrate God's authority over Egypt's gods and nature?
2. **Obedience in Faith:** How does Moses' obedience despite Pharaoh's refusal inspire you to persevere in faith when facing resistance?
3. **God's Justice and Mercy:** How does God's distinction between the Israelites and Egyptians during the plagues show both His justice and mercy?

#### January 31: Exodus 10-12

1. **The Passover's Significance:** How does the institution of the Passover point to God's provision of salvation through the blood of the Lamb?
2. **God's Deliverance:** What does the Exodus story teach about God's power to deliver His people from bondage?
3. **Remembering God's Acts:** Why is it important to commemorate God's faithfulness, as Israel did with the Passover?

#### February 1: Exodus 13-15

1. **Trusting God's Guidance:** How does the pillar of cloud and fire represent God's faithfulness in leading His people?

2. **Crossing the Red Sea:** What does this miraculous event reveal about God's power to save and His ability to make a way in impossible situations?
3. **Songs of Praise:** How does Miriam's song of praise encourage you to respond to God's work in your life with worship?

## February 2: Exodus 16-18

1. **Provision in the Wilderness:** How does God's provision of manna and water in the wilderness challenge you to trust Him for your daily needs?
2. **God's Care Through Others:** How does Jethro's advice to Moses illustrate the importance of delegation and shared leadership?
3. **Relying on God's Strength:** How does the victory over Amalek with Moses' raised hands remind you to rely on God's power in battles you face?

## February 3: Exodus 19-21

1. **God's Holiness at Sinai:** What does God's display of power at Mount Sinai teach about His holiness and how we approach Him?
2. **The Ten Commandments:** How do these laws reflect God's desire for His people to live distinctively as a reflection of His character?
3. **Reverence for God:** How can the Israelites' awe and fear of God at Sinai shape your understanding of worship and obedience?

## February 4: Exodus 22-24

1. **Justice in God's Laws:** How do God's laws about justice and compassion reflect His care for the vulnerable and oppressed?
2. **The Covenant Confirmed:** What does the covenant ceremony in Exodus 24 teach about the significance of commitment and worship in our relationship with God?
3. **God's Presence:** How does Moses' ascent to the mountain and God's invitation into His presence inspire you to seek deeper intimacy with Him?
