

The Bible Recap Discussion Questions

Day 43-49, February 12th-18th

Day 43: Exodus 39-40 (February 12th)

1. God's glory filled the Tabernacle when it was completed. How does this moment highlight the importance of obedience and reverence in worship?
2. The cloud and fire guided the Israelites on their journey. How can we seek God's guidance in our own lives today?
3. What does the completion of the Tabernacle teach about God's faithfulness in fulfilling His plans?

Day 44: Leviticus 1-4 (February 13th)

1. Leviticus begins with offerings for sin and worship. How do these sacrifices foreshadow Jesus' ultimate sacrifice?
2. What do the specific rules for burnt offerings teach about the seriousness of sin and the cost of atonement?
3. How does understanding the Old Testament sacrifices deepen your appreciation for Jesus as the Lamb of God?

Day 45: Leviticus 5-7 (February 14th)

1. How do the guilt offerings address unintentional sins and the need for restitution?
2. What do these chapters teach about the importance of intentionality and awareness in our actions?
3. How can we apply the principles of confession and restitution in our relationships today?

Day 46: Leviticus 8-10 (February 15th)

1. What does the consecration of Aaron and his sons reveal about the holiness required for those who serve God?
2. How does the incident with Nadab and Abihu underscore the importance of approaching God with reverence?
3. In what ways does Jesus serve as our perfect High Priest, surpassing the Levitical priesthood?

Day 47: Leviticus 11–13 (February 16th)

1. What might be the reasons behind the dietary laws distinguishing clean and unclean animals?
2. How do the laws concerning cleanliness and disease emphasize the need for purity among God's people?
3. How does Jesus' ministry challenge or uphold these concepts of cleanliness?

Day 48: Leviticus 14–15 (February 17th)

1. What is the significance of the purification rituals for skin diseases and bodily discharges?
2. How do these rituals reflect the broader theme of holiness in daily life?
3. In what ways does Jesus provide cleansing that goes beyond physical rituals?

Day 49: Leviticus 16–18 (February 18th)

1. How does the Day of Atonement serve as a central theme in Leviticus, and what is its significance?
2. What do the laws in these chapters teach about the sanctity of life and relationships?
3. How does Jesus' sacrificial death fulfill the symbolism of the Day of Atonement?
