Day 43: Exodus 39-40 (February 12th)

- 1. What does the consecration of Aaron and his sons reveal about the holiness required for those who serve God?
- 2. How does the incident with Nadab and Abihu underscore the importance of approaching God with reverence?
- 3. In what ways does Jesus serve as our perfect High Priest, surpassing the Levitical priesthood?

Day 47: Leviticus 11–13 (February 16th)

- 1. What might be the reasons behind the dietary laws distinguishing clean and unclean animals?
