Day 57-63, February 26th-March 4th

Day 57: Numbers 7

- 1. How do the identical offerings from each tribe demonstrate unity and equality among God's people?**
- 2. What does the detailed record of each leader's gift reveal about God's attention to the details of our obedience and worship?**
- 3. How can you give generously to God in a way that reflects your gratitude for His provision?**

Day 58: Numbers 8-9

- 1. What does the consecration of the Levites in Numbers 8 teach about being set apart for God's service?**
- 2. How does the observance of Passover in Numbers 9 remind Israel of God's faithfulness, and how can you apply this principle of remembrance in your own life?**
- 3. What does the cloud over the Tabernacle teach about following God's timing and direction?**

Day 59: Numbers 10-11

- 1. What is the significance of the silver trumpets in Numbers 10, and how does God provide guidance for His people today?**
- 2. How do the Israelites' complaints in Numbers 11 contrast with God's provision, and what lessons can you learn about gratitude?**
- 3. What does Moses' response to the burden of leadership teach about relying on God for strength?**

Day 60: Numbers 12–13

1. How does Miriam and Aaron's criticism of Moses in Numbers 12 highlight the dangers of pride and jealousy?
2. What does the report of the spies in Numbers 13 reveal about faith versus fear in following God's promises?
3. In what areas of your life is God calling you to trust Him despite intimidating circumstances?

Day 61: Numbers 14–15; Psalm 90

1. How does the Israelites' rebellion in Numbers 14 demonstrate the consequences of unbelief, and how can you guard against a similar mindset?
2. What does Moses' intercession for the people reveal about God's mercy and patience?
3. How does Psalm 90 emphasize the brevity of life and the importance of seeking God's wisdom?

Day 62: Numbers 16–17

1. What does Korah's rebellion in Numbers 16 teach about the dangers of pride and challenging God's appointed leadership?
2. How does God confirm Aaron's leadership in Numbers 17, and what does this reveal about His authority?
3. How can you ensure that your heart remains humble and submissive to God's leadership in your life?

Day 63: Numbers 18–19

1. How does God's provision for the Levites in Numbers 18 demonstrate His care for those who serve Him?
2. What is the significance of the purification laws in Numbers 19, and how do they point to Jesus' ultimate cleansing of sin?
3. How can you pursue holiness in your daily life while relying on Christ for purification?
