Parent Information

1. Be praying for camp, Pastor Phillip, Pastor Quinton, and the team, and all that God has planned for our students.

2. Download the church app and turn on notifications if you have not done so already. All of our communication and information is shared via the church website and church app. There is a whole page for beach camp under the Station Students tab. You can find the camp schedule, packing list, and other forms there.

Please keep in mind that the schedule is subject to change at all times.

3. BE ON TIME FOR DROPOFF AT THE STATION CHURCH FRIDAY MORNING!!!

3. Fill out all of the necessary forms for your student. There is a medication form required for any student that takes prescription medication. There is also a transportation form that is required for EVERY person going to camp. Please do this ASAP if you have not done so already. This is how we do our bus rosters and take care of all necessary travel arrangements.

4. Please pack according to the packing list.

5. Swimsuits...please keep it appropriate for a church summer camp.

Boys: At least a 5" inseam.

Girls: No string bikinis, no ruched bottoms.

Most competition games are on the beach, and some are very physical. Please be mindful of that when packing your swimwear.

6. Please encourage your students to stay hydrated. We will have plenty of water, Gatorade, and cooling stations at camp. Make sure to pack that refillable water bottle labeled with your student's name.

7. Rooming assignments will be posted as we get closer to camp. There are still changes being made every day. There will be an adult in every student room, and we have a key manager that will handle all of the keys for the camper rooms. Every adult going to camp has passed an extensive background check.

8. Please encourage your students to have good hygiene at camp. Yes, this is an issue every year. Encourage them to shower every day as well as wear deodorant. Axe body spray is prohibited and does not substitute for a shower!!!

9. We will have a lost and found station setup on Monday morning for the students to look through before they get on the bus to leave camp. Please encourage your students to check for any of their belongings before they leave Laguna.

10. Payment reminders are being sent out. If you have any questions regarding your camp payments please email Pastor Quinton at quinton@thestationchurch.org. Please have your balance paid in full before leaving for camp unless prior arrangements have already been made. **While we do understand that plans sometimes change, no refunds are available after we reach the 2 week window for camp. Final numbers and final payment has already been submitted to Laguna; therefore, these spots have to be paid for in full.**

11. Specific Laguna Beach Christian Retreat Center Details:

- Once students arrive on campus Friday, they will not leave campus until we leave for home on Monday morning.
- There is a camp store that students are allowed to visit. They have camp merch as well as ice cream and a coffee shop. No student is allowed to visit the camp store alone.
- We are aware of recent wildlife activity in the area and will adhere to all policies and flag statues set for the area.
